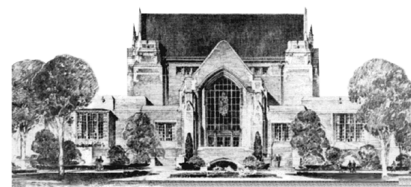

New Electronic Resources

Booth Library subscribes to well over 70 online databases providing our academic community with access to a wide array of reliable information sources not freely available on the Internet. Four of our latest additions are outlined below. They are all available on the Booth Library web site at <http://www.eiu.edu/~booth>.

Associations Unlimited (formerly Encyclopedia of Associations)

This is the online version of the former print resource Encyclopedia of Associations. This database contains information for approximately 460,000 international and U.S. national, regional, state, and local nonprofit membership organizations in all fields, including IRS data on U.S. 501(c) nonprofit organizations. For some 2,600 major U.S. national associations, this resource provides full-text association materials such as brochures, pamphlets, and membership application forms.

Brown University Women Writers Project

The resource includes English texts written by women before 1830, including texts written by Renaissance women writers.

*ERIC Document Reproduction Service (E*Subscribe Online)*

This database provides full-text ERIC documents online. This resource is an excellent supplement to the FirstSearch and OVID ERIC databases, providing online access to documents previously available only on microfiche.

New Grove Dictionary of Music and Musicians, 2nd Edition

This is the most comprehensive reference for all aspects of music, including over 29,000 articles on music, musical instruments and musicians from the past and present.
