

Installing and Using OverDrive Media Console To Play Audio Books and Videos from MyMediaMall

Download the [OverDrive Media Console](#) to Your Windows PC

Click [here](#) to download the OverDrive Media Console.

The OverDrive Installer will download to your computer.

Launch the application to install it on your computer. You will only need to do this once.

The Default settings will be correct for most users.

Refer to the [Download and Installation Instructions](#) web site if you encounter any installation problems.

Once installation is complete, OverDrive will upgrade Windows Media Player so that it can play MediaMall DRM protected files.

Windows Media Player Security Upgrade Instructions.

The Windows Media Security Upgrade is a process that must be performed before Microsoft Windows Media Player will allow any DRM-protected files to be played. A security measure, the security update identifies the copy of Windows Media Player with the computer on which the Player is being used.

The first time that you open OverDrive Media Console after installation, OverDrive Media Console checks to see if you need to complete the security upgrade. If a security upgrade is needed, a message is displayed notifying you that in order to play protected content, you must first upgrade the security of your Windows Media Player. Follow the instructions provided in the message to complete the security update.

Complete the security upgrade as follows (6 steps):

1. While connected to the Internet, open OverDrive Media Console.
2. Go to *Tools > Windows Media Player Security Upgrade*.
A dialog box is displayed, notifying you that your Windows Media Player requires a security upgrade to play protected content.
3. Click 'OK' in the dialog box.
Windows Media Player opens and, the 'Security Upgrade Required' dialog box is displayed.
4. Click 'OK' in the 'Security Upgrade Required' dialog box to perform the upgrade.
The 'License Acquisition' dialog box is displayed, indicating that you have installed the Windows Media Player Security Upgrade.
5. Click the 'Play' button in the 'License Acquisition' dialog box to complete the upgrade.
Windows Media Player plays a brief file, confirming that you have completed the upgrade.
6. Click the 'Cancel' button to close the 'License Acquisition' dialog box. If desired, you can also close Windows Media Player at this time.
You have successfully completed the Windows Media Player Security Upgrade.

Return to MyMediaMall

Click the link to return to [MyMediaMall](http://mymediamaill.net) or type <http://mymediamaill.net>

Select the Video or Audio Book that you would like and add to your cart. Complete the checkout process and you will then be ready to download the media files to your computer.

Downloading a media file to OverDrive:

Click **Download**.



On the next window make sure to select **Open with: OverDrive Media Console**. Note: You may not see this window if OverDrive is already set to be the primary player for this media type.



Click **OK**.

OverDrive should launch automatically.

A window will appear with the title and folder location of the media being downloaded. Confirm information and click **OK**.

If a message about the specified default folder does not exist, say **YES**.

Next window will show the selected parts to download.

Click **OK**.

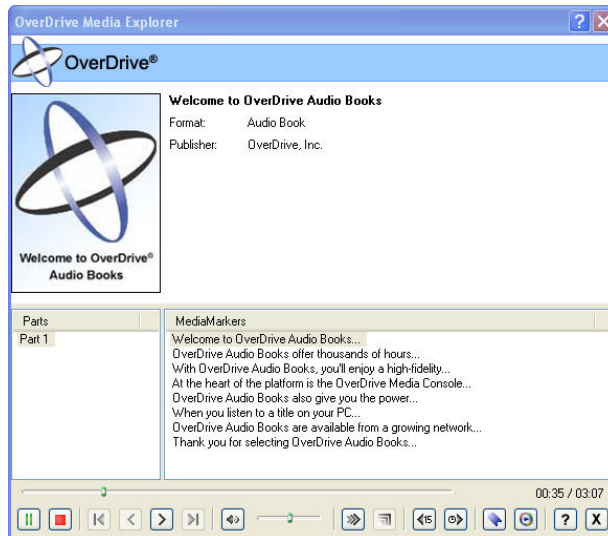
The Progress bar on the bottom right of the OverDrive Console window will show the download progress.

Once the download is complete you may choose to **PLAY** or **TRANSFER** the media file to a portable player or **BURN** it to a CD.

How to Use Your Audio Book

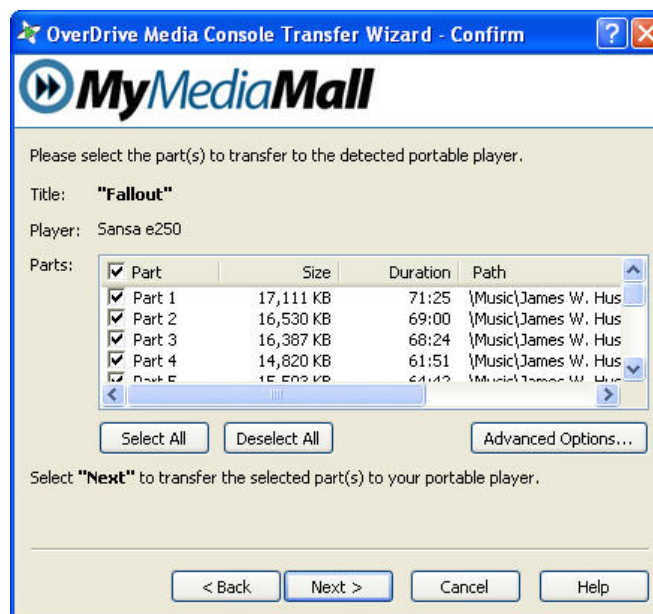
Play

Selecting **Play** will give you a window to navigate through the downloaded audio book.



Transfer

If selecting to **Transfer** to a portable player, make sure that your player is supported and that it has enough room for the files being downloaded.



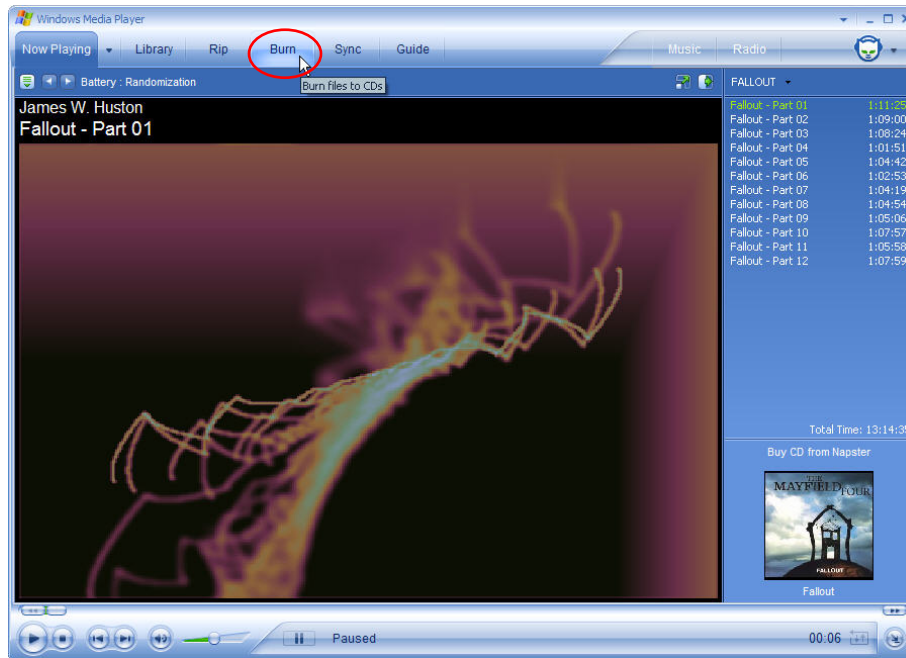
Please note that iPod is not supported.

Burn

If selecting the **Burn** function, OverDrive will launch Windows Media Player to burn the media file to a CD.

Click **OK** to continue to Windows Media Player

Click on the **Burn** tab in Windows Media Player to launch the CD burning wizard.



Your windows and options may be different depending on the version of Windows Media Player that you have installed.

Notes:

OverDrive will only work on Microsoft Windows PC's and Laptops.

OverDrive requires Windows Media Player with Digital Rights Management.

OverDrive must be installed on the computer prior to downloading the media files.
